Move ups will be allowed on the day of trial.

Competitors in regular classes shall be provided with a 10-minute period at the beginning of the event during which they may walk the course (without dog) and ask the Judge questions. If there are more than 20 competitors, an additional 10 minutes will be provided (after every 20 competitors) for course-walking and questions. For the C level and Team competition, the walk through time is 3 minutes.

Please note that this is a CARO sponsored trial and there will be Shadow Judging taking place at the event. Extra time will be taken between course changes for the Judge to confer with the shadow judges.

When allowed, food or toys MUST be in the RIGHT HAND POCKET of the handler and out of sight. NO TREAT/BAIT BAGS. NO ACTIVE TOYS (clickers, squeak toys, etc.). To keep the event running smoothly, all competitors will be expected to keep track of the running order and to be in the "on deck" area prior to your run.

No choke, martingale, prong or shock collars, head halters or no-pull harnesses are allowed. All dogs in all classes must enter and exit the ring with a collar and lead. Please see the CARO website for rules and regulations.

IMPORTANT

All dogs competing must be registered with CARO to compete. Registration forms are available at <http://www.canadianrallyo.ca> and must be submitted to CARO before the trial or accompany your entry. If submitting with your entry, please submit the CARO Dog ID form along with a cheque payable to CARO along with your cheque payable to Crazy Jumpers for regular entry. We will ensure that CARO receives the information. Registering your dog is your responsibility.

FACILITIES: Arborg is a one hour drive north of Winnipeg along Highway 7 (see map below). This is an indoor facility in Arborg with a very large parking area in front of the building. Indoor crating is available and there are washrooms and water on site. Bring your own lunch or take advantage of numerous restaurants/grocery stores within a 2 minute drive. Arborg's local eateries include a Subway, a Chicken Chef and other local restaurants. Hotels that are dog friendly in the area include the Travelling Inn @ 204-376-5261 and the Arborg Hotel @ 204-376-5453 Arborg also has a campground at the Heritage Village, and Hnaua Provincial Park on the shores of Lake Winnipeg is a 10 minute drive away.



All dogs must be crated, in an x-pen, or on leash when not in the ring. Any dog displaying aggressive behaviour at any time will be asked to leave the trial grounds.

We ask that NO dogs are exercised directly in front of the building. Please go to the grassy area on the East side of the building. There is a large grassed park-like area behind the arena (north) if you would like to take your dog for a walk. Any person deliberately allowing their dog to use the area in front of the building may be asked to leave and forfeit their entry fees.

FLOORING: The arena surface is cement. Please wear proper footwear. Mats have been placed at stations with obstacles for dog's safety.

Spectators will be allowed at this event.

NO SMOKING, VAPING, CANNIBIS, OR ALCOHOL ON THE PROPERTY.

CHILDREN MUST BE SUPERVISED BY A PARENT NOT COMPETING.

ANYONE OBSERVED NOT PICKING UP AFTER THEIR DOG WILL BE EXCUSED AND WILL FORFEIT ENTRY FEES.

AN OFFICIATING JUDGE, AND/OR THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE TRIAL, MAY DISMISS FROM THE TRIAL SITE ANY PERSON SUBJECTING THE JUDGE, MEMBERS OF THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE OR FELLOW EXHIBITORS TO ABUSE, WHETHER THAT PERSON IS COMPETING IN THE TRIAL OR NOT.

ANYONE OBSERVED DISCIPLINING THEIR DOG IN A MANNER THAT OFFENDS A JUDGE'S SENSIBILITIES WILL BE EXCUSED AND WILL FORFEIT ENTRY FEES.

AWARDS

Purple qualifying ribbons will be awarded for scores of 170 or better in regular classes, 180 or better for Team and Versatility and 190 or better for C Stream. Rosettes will be awarded for new titles.
