Competitors in regular classes shall be provided with a 10-minute period at the beginning of the event during which they may walk the course (without dog) and ask the Judge questions. If there are more than 20 competitors, an additional 10 minutes will be provided (after every 20 competitors) for course-walking and questions. For the C level and Team competition, the walk through time is 3 minutes. **** Face masks are required for the walk through. No mask – no walk through.**

When allowed, food or toys MUST be in the RIGHT HAND POCKET of the handler and out of sight. NO TREAT/BAIT BAGS. NO ACTIVE TOYS (clickers, squeak toys, etc.). To keep the event running smoothly, all competitors will be expected to keep track of the running order and to be in the “on deck” area prior to your run.

No choke, martingale, prong or shock collars, head halters or no-pull harnesses are allowed. All dogs in all classes must enter and exit the ring with a collar and lead. Please see the CARO website for rules and regulations.

IMPORTANT

All dogs competing must be registered with CARO to compete. Registration forms are available at <http://www.canadianrallyo.ca> and must be submitted to CARO before the trial or accompany your entry. If submitting with your entry, please submit the CARO Dog ID form along with a cheque payable to CARO along with your cheque payable to Crazy Jumpers for regular entry. We will ensure that CARO receives the information. Registering your dog is your responsibility.

CARO MEMBERS RECEIVE DISCOUNTED ENTRY FEES. MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION AVAILABLE AT <http://www.canadianrallyo.ca> THIS APPLICATION MUST BE SUBMITTED TO CARO FOR PROCESSING. MEMBERSHIP NUMBER MUST BE INCLUDED ON TRIAL ENTRY FOR DISCOUNT. (The CARO Dog Registration Number is NOT the CARO Membership Number).

FACILITIES This is an indoor facility in Arborg. Indoor crating space is available and there are washrooms and water on site. Bring your own lunch or take advantage of numerous restaurants/grocery stores within a 10 minute drive. All dogs must be crated, in an x-pen, or on leash when not in the ring. Any dog displaying aggressive behaviour at any time will be asked to leave the trial grounds.

We ask that NO dogs are exercised directly in front of the building. Please use the area to the east of the building. There is a large field area to the north behind the arena as well. Any person deliberately allowing their dog to use the area in front of the building may be asked to leave and forfeit their entry fees.

FLOORING: The arena surface is cement. The whole of the floor in the ring will be covered with carpet. Please wear proper footwear.

NO SMOKING, VAPING, CANNIBIS, OR ALCOHOL ON THE PROPERTY.

CHILDREN MUST BE SUPERVISED BY A PARENT NOT COMPETING.

ANYONE OBSERVED NOT PICKING UP AFTER THEIR DOG WILL BE EXCUSED AND WILL FORFEIT ENTRY FEES.

AN OFFICIATING JUDGE, AND/OR THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE TRIAL, MAY DISMISS FROM THE TRIAL SITE ANY PERSON SUBJECTING THE JUDGE, MEMBERS OF THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE OR FELLOW EXHIBITORS TO ABUSE, WHETHER THAT PERSON IS COMPETING IN THE TRIAL OR NOT.

ANYONE OBSERVED DISCIPLINING THEIR DOG IN A MANNER THAT OFFENDS A JUDGE'S SENSIBILITIES WILL BE EXCUSED AND WILL FORFEIT ENTRY FEES.

AWARDS

Purple qualifying ribbons will be awarded for scores of 170 or better in regular classes, 180 or better for Team and Versatility and 190 or better for C Stream. Rosettes will be awarded for new titles.

RALLY OBEDIENCE DESCRIPTION

COVID-19

To prevent the spread of COVID-19 please consider the following:

DO NOT COME TO THE EVENT IF you, or anyone in your household, has returned from out of Manitoba in the last 14 days.

DO NOT COME TO THE EVENT IF you, or anyone in your household, is experiencing flu/cold symptoms.

DO NOT COME TO THE EVENT IF you, or anyone in your household, has been directed to self-isolate.

Wash your hands often throughout the day. Do not touch your face with your hands.

Do not ask anyone to hold your dog, leash or collar.

Do not ask people to use your phone to record your run, transfer at a distance using airdrop or some other means.

Do not touch gates or door-handles, the gate-steward will open and close the gate.

Please use the hand- sanitizer that will be set up at multiple stations.

Maximum 2 people per dog, household members only. No children under 12 years of age.

Please maintain social distancing of at least 6ft (2 meters) at all times, including outside.

Do not handle other competitors equipment or touch dogs that are not your own.

Bring a dish and water for your dog and poop bags.
